



BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING LINEAIRE MARKETING AND AIRCONDITIONING SERVICES A LOWEST CALCULATED RESPONSIVE BID

Contract: "One (1) Lot Supply, Installation and Commissioning of New Individualized Inverter Air-conditioning Units and its Electrical Requirements Including the Decommissioning of Existing Central Air-conditioning Equipment and its Accessories" per Invitation to Bid No. IB16-375555-05 and ABC of P10,400,000.⁰⁰

WHEREAS, the Academy for the contract cited above with the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of P10,400,000.⁰⁰ advertised the Invitation to Bid in one of the newspapers (The Philippine Star) on November 15, 2016 (Tuesday) and posted the same in the PhilGEPS and DAP websites and within conspicuous places at the DAP premises continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, three (3) Prospective Bidders:

- 1) First Flow HVAC Technologies, Inc. (FFHTI);
 - 2) Lineaire Marketing and Airconditioning Services (LMAS); and
 - 3) Cool Airconditioning and Refrigeration Industries, Inc. (CARII);
- ... bought the Official Bid Documents (OBD) at P15,000.⁰⁰ each;

WHEREAS, all the three (3) Prospective Bidders attended the Pre-Bid Conference conducted last November 24, 2016 (Thursday), 10:00AM held at the 3B Floor, Kennedy Room, DAP Building, Pasig City;

WHEREAS, based on the discussions and agreements made during the Pre-Bid Conference, the Bid Bulletin Nos. 1 and 2 were issued on November 25 and 29, 2016 respectively. This were posted at the PhilGEPS and DAP websites and e-mail to two (3) Prospective Bidders who bought the OBD;

WHEREAS, on the scheduled submission and opening of Technical (including Eligibility) and Financial proposals of Bid last December 07, 2016 (Wednesday), 10:00AM at the 3B Floor, Kennedy Room, DAP Bldg., Pasig City, the three (3) Bidders submitted the bid proposals;

WHEREAS, the technical (including the eligibility) documents of FFHTI, the 1st bidder who bought the OBD was opened and the requirements of the bid were not all present. Eligibility Document marked E10 was absent and declared its bid "Ineligible". The authorized

representative submitted a Waiver to File a Request for Reconsideration;

WHEREAS, the technical (including the eligibility) and financial documents of **LMAS**, the 2nd bidder who bought the OBD was opened and the requirements of the bid were all present. Bidder **LMAS** bid was declared "**Eligible**" as to present/ absent of documents;

WHEREAS, the technical (including the eligibility) and financial documents of **CARII**, the 3rd bidder who bought the OBD was opened and the requirements of the bid were all present. Bidder **CARII**'s bid was declared "**Eligible**" as to present/ absent of documents;

WHEREAS, the details of the bid proposal of "eligible" bidders are shown below:

WHEREAS, the assessment of the **LMAS** bid proposal by the Technical Working Group (TWG) was conducted on the next day, December 8, 2016 (Thursday) at the General Services Division office, Basement, DAP Bldg., Pasig City;






WHEREAS, the results of assessment/ evaluation of TWG was forwarded to BAC through a memorandum dated December 16, 2016 (Friday). It was recommended to BAC that **LMAS**, bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid be clarified/ affirmed on the Bid Bulletin No. 1 (BB1) which was attached to its bid proposal with signature of the Bidder's authorized representative means compliance on its contents. The BAC clarified the issue raised by the TWG regarding affirmation on its compliance to BB1 through email sent to **LMAS** on December 19, 2017 (Monday). The **LMAS** affirmed that the signed BB1 means compliance on its reply through email received on December 20, 2016 (Tuesday);

WHEREAS, upon thorough assessment, evaluation and post-qualification, the TWG established the responsiveness of **LMAS** bid. The TWG, in a memorandum dated January 03, 2017 (Tuesday), recommended to the BAC that **LMAS** bid be declared as the **Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid**;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, we, the Members of the BAC, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

01. To declare the bid of **Lineaire Marketing and Airconditioning Services**, the bidder with Lowest Calculated Bid as the "**Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid**"; and
02. To recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity the foregoing BAC-concluded findings to declare the bid of **Lineaire Marketing and Airconditioning Services** as the **Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid**.
